

## ANDY SWANN VOYAGE - SIGNATURE COLLECTION

### *Art and Artists of the Riviera and Provence*

Whether your taste in art leans towards the classical or contemporary, medieval or Modernism, there's something for everyone on the South of France art circuit. From Menton to Aix-en-Provence, the coastal route is studded with world-class museums, foundations and galleries devoted to individual artists, as well as significant collections focused on particular schools and periods. Accompanied by an expert guide, discover the varied and complex work of Jean Cocteau in Villefranche-sur-Mer and Menton, then head to Nice to visit the world's largest Chagall collection, including works specifically created for the museum. Take a comprehensive look at Matisse's life work in Nice and Vence, setting aside time for lunch at Saint-Paul-de-Vence's legendary *Colombe d'Or* and a stop at the modern and contemporary collection at the Fondation Maeght. Visit the home where Renoir lived and worked in Haut-de-Cagnes, then follow the coastline to Biot, Antibes, and Le Cannet to see work by Léger, Picasso and Bonnard. For something out of the ordinary, head to Mougins to discover one of the region's finest small museums, a private collection of both classical and modern art ranging from ancient Roman armor and Egyptian sarcophagi to works by Andy Warhol and Damien Hirst. Further afield in Saint-Rémy, Arles and Aix-en-Provence, follow the historic footsteps of Van Gogh and Cezanne, then extend your Provence excursion with a special art-and-wine day at a private domain, tasting the Château's exceptional wines and wandering through its extraordinary collection of sculptures by leading contemporary masters. Our Signature Collection Art and Artists of the Riviera and Provence itinerary is designed to be a feast for the eyes as well as the spirit.
