With stunning landscapes, perched villages, and charming cities, Provence is nothing if not picturesque. Explore underground caves in the perched village of Gordes, then emerge from the tunnel into a private garden where a refreshing aperitif awaits you. Visit one of the oldest synagogues in France, established in 1367 and still active today. Savor the flavors and the scents of Provence during visits to a lavender distillery, a goat cheese farm or a local vineyard, or join in a truffle hunt with trained truffle dogs. Spend a sunny afternoon hiking through the brilliant red and gold canyons of Roussillon's ochre trail, then learn about the art of using natural ochre pigments in a private workshop. Cycle through the countryside on your own steam or using electric bicycles, or experience the thrill of kayaking on the river Sorgue. Learn about the artistic heritage of the region during visits to museums and galleries with your private guide, but also in the studios of working painters and sculptors. Dine at Michelin-starred restaurants or quaint local *brasseries*, or opt for a gastronomic picnic in the shade of olive trees.
