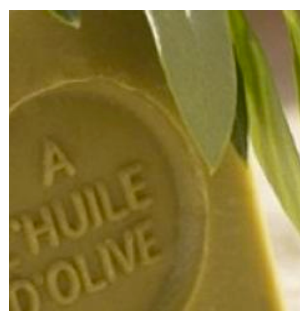

Drive along the breath-taking coastline from Cap Ferrat and Villefranche-su-Mer, then stop to explore the multifaceted city of Nice, with its colourful old town, Italianate architecture and sea-facing Promenade. Take in some of the region’s art and cultural highlights in Saint-Paul-de-Vence, or get a true taste of the region as you sample olives, cheese, fresh oysters and *socca* in Antibes’ covered *Marché Provençale*. Head to Cannes for some elegant shopping along the *Croisette*, or venture further along the coast to Saint-Tropez, with its unique blend of fishing-village charm and contemporary chic. When you’re ready to move on, begin your Provence experience in Aix-en-Provence, the birthplace of Cezanne, with its elegant, tree-lined avenues, then continue on to Saint-Rémy, surrounded by vineyards and steeped in the history of Vincent Van Gogh. Visit the foundation dedicated to Van Gogh in Arles, along with the city’s famous Roman amphitheatre, then experience the elegance of Avignon, with its historic centre and Papal Palace. Whatever your personal tastes and travel schedule, our Taste of the Riviera and Provence itinerary is designed to offer you a memorable “best-of” experience of the South of France.
