Head to Opio and Grasse to sample some of the region's finest olives and olive oils at family-run mills, or take a guided tour through a private olive grove, followed by tea in the garden with the proprietor, an English Lady. Discover the magic of Côte de Provence rosés on a wine route from Nice to Saint-Tropez, stopping for private tastings at Châteaux along the way, or treat yourself to an exclusive tasting in a private villa, hosted by a Master of Wine. Join a professional chef for a walking tour of Nice's *Marché Provençale*, followed by a cooking class and lunch. Or spend a leisurely Sunday morning browsing through Antibes' open-air market, sampling fresh goat cheeses, spicy *saucissons*, and delicate *macarons* before stopping at a local café for an aperitif, accompanied by oysters or a slice of *socca*, the traditional chickpea "crêpe". And for something truly special, head further afield to Carpentras or across the French/Italian border to Alba, two fantastic truffle and wine areas where you can enjoy hunting for truffles with local hunters and their dogs.
