Provençal Garden Visit

The Estate of an English Lady




Spend the day visiting the olive groves and perfume gardens of an English Lady. Take a private guided tour of the gallery followed by a demonstration of the glassblowing process, then experience the art of glassblowing first-hand during a private workshop where you will learn to use the blowpipe to create your own piece of art glass.

Options *Extend this program to include a gastronomic experience, during which a master chef, working in collaboration with the glassblowers, prepares and cooks a selection of sweet and savoury dishes under the heat of a hand-blown glass dome.*

Private Museum Visit

The Artists' Village of Mougins



Situated in the heart of the charming hilltop artists' village, the *Mougins Museum of Classical Art* is a unique and eclectic private collection ranging from ancient Egyptian sarcophagi, Greek sculpture and Roman armour to works by Yves Klein, Andy Warhol, and other Modern and Contemporary masters. Enjoy exclusive private access to the museum during a guided visit conducted by the museum's founder and owner.

Options *Extend this experience to include a gastronomic lunch, cocktail, apero-dinatoire or dinner, prepared by a master chef and his team and served in the exclusive setting of the privatized museum.*

Perfume Creation Experience

With its famous perfume houses such as *Fragonard*, *Galimard* and *Molinard* and its hillsides covered with terraced gardens, Grasse has earned a global reputation as the world capital of perfume. Experience the art of perfume creation first-hand during an exclusive workshop with a master perfume maker. Under her guidance, discover the essences that go into perfume, then select and blend them to create your personalized *Eau de Parfum*.

Options *Combine this experience with wine tasting, discovering the parallels between perfume essences and wine aromas, the similarities between the roles of the perfumer and the sommelier.*

Discover the latest trends of top designers as well as unique fashions from exclusive boutiques during a half- or full-day outing with a professional private style advisor / image consultant / personal shopper. Exploring the South of France by 2CV



Experience the ultimate luxury of a day spent entirely at leisure, enjoying the expertise and local knowledge of a driver-guide but without the constraints of a fixed schedule. Set the pace and select the program, based on your guide's suggestions and the options available on the day¹. Be as whimsical as you wish: Explore hilltop villages, go on a shopping spree, or simply bask in the sun of a seaside café. The day is yours to do exactly as you please.

Options *Engage your personal driver-guide for multiple days and expand your travel program to include both the Riviera and Provence.*

Terms and Conditions

DEPOSITS The payment of a deposit is required in order to reserve any tour or service proposed by Andy Swann Voyage. An itinerary is not considered confirmed until a deposit payment has been made on all tours and services in the itinerary, including guide services.

Unless otherwise specified, a **non-refundable** initial deposit of 20% of the total cost of the itinerary is due upon receipt of the Deposit Invoice (or the Invoice if paying in full).

A payment of a deposit indicates an acceptance of all the terms and conditions below by the purchaser and/or Client.

PAYMENTS All itineraries must be paid in full at least 30 days before the start of the tour or service.

Itineraries booked 30 days or less before the start of a tour or service must be paid in full at the time of booking; this payment is **non-refundable** as per the Cancellation and Refund policy below.

For itineraries booked more than 30 days before the start of a tour or service, where the 20% deposit has already been paid, the payment of the remaining 80% of the total cost of the itinerary must be made at least 30 days before the starting date of the tour or service.

Additional Fees Unless explicitly stated in the itinerary as pre-paid or included, all tickets, entrance fees, meals, gratuities and other incidental expenses are the responsibility of the Client and will either be (1) paid by the Client on site or (2) **invoiced to the Client upon the completion of travel**, with payment due upon receipt of the invoice.

Driver guide services are based on either a half-day rate (up to 4 hours) or a full-day rate (from 4 hours to a maximum 8 hours). Additional hours are charged at the rate of EUR 150/hour, calculated as full hours from the first 15 minutes of overtime and **invoiced to the client upon completion of the service**, with payment due upon receipt of the invoice.

Driver services are based on a rate of EUR 150/hour for a minimum of 5 hours. Additional hours are charged at the rate of EUR 150/hour, calculated as full hours from the first 15 minutes of overtime and **invoiced to the client upon completion of travel**, with payment due upon receipt of the invoice.

RESERVATIONS Andy Swann Voyage will make reservations on behalf of the client for third-party services such as restaurants, yachts and transfers. In order to secure the booking, the client must provide a valid credit card as a guarantee of payment for all requested services.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

In the event of the cancellation of an itinerary by the Client, refunds will be made based on a percentage of the total cost of the tour/itinerary as shown below:

Cancellation period	Refunded to Client	Retained by ASV
60 days or more before the start of the tour/activity	80%	20%
60-31 days before the start of the tour/activity	50%	50%
30 days or less before the start of the tour/activity	0%	100%

Refunds will under no circumstance be issued to those failing to join their tour, or for tour accommodation or any other services not utilized, or for a partially completed vacation.

All venue visits and activities proposed in the client itinerary are subject to availability on the date of travel. In the event that a venue visit or activity is not possible on the date/time indicated, Andy Swann Voyage will make every effort to reschedule the activity or substitute a similar activity.

Andy Swann Voyage reserves the right to cancel any tour or service in the event of *force majeure* or other circumstances beyond our control. In the event of a cancellation by Andy Swann Voyage, no liability shall fall upon Andy Swann Voyage.

In the case of a cancellation of a service provided by a third-party provider (such as a restaurant reservation or driver transfer), the client is liable for any cancellation fee imposed by the service provider in addition to any cancellation fee imposed by Andy Swann Voyage.
